

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROARING SPRING, BLAIR COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, LIMITING THE PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF COMMERCIAL/CONSTRUCTION VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS OF THE BOROUGH OF ROARING SPRING

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Roaring Spring, Blair County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION NO. 1 – DEFINITIONS

A. Recreational Vehicles – Defined as a camper, motor home, trailer or self-contained vehicle utilized as a camper or motor home. Any boat or personal watercraft with or without a trailer or other towing device utilized to transport a boat or water craft of any type and any other vehicle or device which could be used for recreational purposes.

B. Commercial/Construction Vehicles – Any tractor trailer, any combination thereof and any and all large vehicles used for business purposes, including but not limited to large box trucks and , large vans used to haul any type of equipment or freight of any type.

SECTION NO. 2 – VIOLATIONS

A. No. person shall park or permit to be parked any recreational vehicle, as defined, on any street or alley situated within the Borough of Roaring Spring for a period not to exceed 48 hours. When so parked, the vehicle must be legally registered and display a valid registration plate and inspection sticker as required by the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code. Any recreational vehicle parked for a period of longer than 48 hours is subject to removal by the Police Department and a citation will be issued to the registered owner of the vehicle.

B. No person shall park or permit to be parked any Commercial Construction vehicle as defined, at any time in residential areas of the Borough of Roaring Spring. Commercial/Construction vehicles in the process of loading and/or unloading equipment or freight shall not be left running for a period not to exceed 30 minutes. Commercial/Construction vehicles shall not be parked on streets or alleys in Commercially Zoned areas for periods not to exceed 2 hours. Those vehicles, so parked shall be completely shut down and no component of the vehicle shall be left running to include refrigerator units or similar devises. When parked, said vehicles must conform to all Pennsylvania Department of Transportation rules and regulations and must comply with all motor vehicle code regulations. Overnight parking of Commercial/Construction vehicles found to be in violation of this section may be

removed at the direction of any Police Officer and the owner of the vehicle will be responsible for any costs incurred with the removal of said vehicle. Furthermore, the registered owner of said vehicle, in addition to the person driving said vehicle, shall be responsible and subject to the provisions of this Ordinance. Each day this Ordinance is violated shall be a separation violation.

### SECTION NO. 3 – PENALTIES

A. Any person/persons violating any section of this Ordinance will be subject to a fine of not less than \$25.00 per day and not more than \$300.00 per day per violation.
