

ORDINANCE NO. 1994 - 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROARING SPRING AMENDING
THE SIDEWALK ORDINANCE NO. 1992-2 ADDING PROVISIONS
RELATING TO SNOW REMOVAL

This Sidewalk Ordinance shall hereafter have a provision
called SECTION 13, which shall read as follows:

"Requirements of owners of property in the Borough
of Roaring Spring to remove snow and ice from their
sidewalks." All owners of property in the Borough of
Roaring Spring which have a sidewalk abutting said
property shall remove snow or ice accumulating on
the sidewalk of their property within twenty-four (24)
hours of when the snow ceased to fall or the ice formed
and do the same with a path no less than eighteen (18)
inches across said sidewalk. The duties under this
Section to remove the snow or ice shall be upon the
person, firm or corporation occupying or using the
property along or in front of which the sidewalk lays.
In case the property is unoccupied or vacant, the
duty shall be upon the owners thereof. In case of
heavy snows or unusual accumulation of ice, the 24-hour
time period may be extended by the Mayor, Chief of
Police or Borough Administrator. Any person violating
this Section shall be guilty of a summary offense and
shall pay a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than
\$300.00 and/or be incarcerated for a maximum of ninety
(90) days. Furthermore, if the person violating this
Section has not removed the snow or ice and the

Borough of Roaring Spring removes said ice or snow at its cost, the person violating this Section shall also be responsible for said snow or ice removal costs. This provision, however, is not intended to place any burden upon the Borough to remove said snow or ice. Each day that the condition persists in violation of this Ordinance, shall be a separate offense. All other provisions of Sidewalk Ordinance No. 1992-2 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 11 and Section 14 of Ordinance 46 are herewith repealed. All other provisions of Ordinance 46 shall remain in full force and effect.
