

**ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF ROARING SPRING, BLAIR COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING THE BOROUGH'S
NUISANCE ORDINANCE REGARDING
THE ENCLOSURE OF SWIMMING POOLS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Roaring Spring passed Ordinance Number 1998-4 regarding the protection of the public health; defining nuisances and declaring certain conditions, places and things to be nuisances and prohibiting the same; providing for the abatement thereof and penalties for the violation thereof; and repealing and amending parts of previous ordinances (“the Nuisance Ordinance”); and,

WHEREAS, the Nuisance Ordinance was amended pursuant to Ordinance 2005-1 wherein a nuisance was defined to include any swimming pool that is not enclosed by a fence or other enclosure at least five feet in height; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough now wishes to amend the Nuisance Ordinance to define which swimming pools must be fenced.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF ROARING SPRING, as follows:**

1. Section 3, Number 12 of Ordinance Number 1998-4, as amended by Ordinance Number 2005-1, is amended to read as follows:
 12. Any swimming pool in excess of twenty-four inches (24") in depth that is not enclosed as required by the applicable provisions of the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code.
2. All other portions of the Nuisance Ordinance not inconsistent with this amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
